



HOW DO I INSTALL WALL GRAPHICS?

If your decal is rolled up, lay it flat until the curl has gone from the decal. Don't be stingy with the masking tape and *take your time*.

Step 1. Completely clean and dry the desired application surface. Use a warm damp cloth with water or rubbing alcohol. **DO NOT USE CLEANING AGENTS!** Allow the area to dry completely.

Small Decals

- **Step 2.** Carefully peel the backing paper from the decal at a sharp angle.
- **Step 3.** Align the decal and press it onto the desired surface. Firmly run a credit card across the transfer tape to make sure the decal adheres to the surface.
- **Step 4.** Slowly peel the transfer tape from the top of the decal. If any part of the decal starts to come up with the tape, run over that part of the decal with a credit card and try to peel the tape again.

Large Decals - Top Hinge Method

- **Step 2.** Align the decal where you would like it to be. Tape it in place using masking tape along the top edge of the decal.
- **Step 3.** Lift the free end of the decal up and peel the backing paper away from the bottom half of the decal at a sharp angle. Cut about half of the backing paper away.
- **Step 4.** Starting from the middle of the decal near where the backing paper ends, wipe down over the decal with a credit card. Firmly go over the bottom half of the decal until it is completely adhered to the surface.
- **Step 5.** Remove the remaining backing paper and start smoothing the decal onto the surface from the bottom working your way up.

Wider decals may benefit from the Center Hinge Method. It is just like the Top Hinge Method, except you are working left and right instead of up and down.
